High School Art Contest

Attention, Artists! Explore new directions in your artistic skills and enter our annual art contest. Here are the contest guidelines and prizes:

CONTEST GUIDELINES

The contest is open to students in Georgia, grades 9 through 12, for the 2018-2019 academic year.

- The finished artwork must be on 8.5x11-inch white paper. It should be created entirely in black, white and gray in a variety of media including graphite, charcoal, pastel, chalk, colored pencil, pen-and-ink, ballpoint pen, and mixed media appropriate for printing.
- One entry per person. Multiple entries will be disqualified.
- The student must be willing to allow Farm Bureau to reprint copies of their drawings. The winning artwork becomes the property of Georgia Farm Bureau.
- All information on the entry form must be completed, including the signature of the parent or guardian.
- Entries should be submitted to the county Farm Bureau office by the deadline set by the county. Each county will select one winner at the county level and submit it to the state level by the deadline date of Friday, March 8, 2019.
- Drawings will be judged on the following:
 - How well the artwork represents modern agriculture found in the student's county or in Georgia
 - Artistic Merit

Previous state winners are not eligible.

PRIZES

- **District Winner:** 10 District Winners will receive **\$100** cash each
- **State Runners-Up (2):** **\$150** cash (in addition to the district award)
- **State Winner:** **\$250** cash (in addition to the district award)
